High school seniors, find out how you can become eligible for a \$15,000 college sponsorship!

United Friends of the Children is committed to ensuring that **current and former foster youth** have access to a high quality education and the opportunity to pursue their goals. The College Sponsorship Program offers students \$3,000 a year for up to five years for college-related expenses, as well as ongoing support to promote graduation from college.

Eligibility

- Los Angeles County foster or probation youth currently in their SENIOR year of high school.
- Seniors with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or above (Students with a 2.7-2.9 may be considered) and plans to attend a four-year college or university.
- Seniors who are committed to fulfilling their educational goals.

Referral Process

Please provide the following information when making a referral by e-mail, fax, or phone:

- Student's full name, address, phone number, & date of birth
- Name of the high school and their anticipated date of graduation
- Cumulative GPA based on the most recent reporting period
- Name of caregiver & type of placement
- Referring party's name, phone number, & organization (If other than the student)

Upon receiving a referral, UFC will mail the application directly to the student. Completed applications are **due January 16, 2008.**
